

ETJ Baseball Meeting



October 12, 2015

Meeting was called to order by Vice President, Ron Brown at 7:00 p.m. at the municipal building.

Motion to accept the minutes for September 2015: Mark Svencer and Terry Hall.

Treasurer Report: Shawn gave the treasurer's report. The balance stands at: **\$6,815. 49**. We do not currently have many bills going out. Paul has accepted the job of the 10U tournament coordinator. Chad will be the 8U tournament coordinator. **We still need someone to run the 12U tournament.** It was suggested that we break up the 10/12 tournaments. This will be discussed at a later date.

We set dates for Baseball/ Softball registration. The dates will be January 9 (Saturday) and January 14 (Thursday evening) and the final sign-ups will be February 6 (Saturday). The draft will follow shortly after sign-ups. In late November, the baseball signs will need to be placed in the township. We will place signs at Martins, Kimmie's and Nagle's house again.

Stephen Ruddek was not available to update on softball. He did mention via text that the signs are still up and Leidy. He will get together with someone and make sure that they come down soon.

Ron is going to book the Nanty-Glo Firehall for the basket party on Sunday, April 10th. All information will be ready to go at sign-ups this year. Charlie also suggested, as another way to

bring some funds to the league, having a Firemen vs. Police game. We will look to do this in June or July over a weekend.

Charlie reported that he drained the hot water tank at the concession stand. The township as now turned the water off for the winter season. Paul mentioned moving the bases for the winter indoors and closing something to the shed.

Paul also mentioned that he talked with someone in charge of the new power plant that is coming in. They are likely to sponsor; we will try for a score board from them. We also discussed some other area businesses that may be willing to sponsor, but are not at this point.

Clearances are now free to obtain for volunteers. We will now expect anyone that helps to have their clearances updated every year.

Central Cambria's Midget football is moving to Colver- to the old baseball fields. The fields are being torn down, so we are going to inquire about buying their old fencing for Leidy.

We will be decorating a tree again for Jackson's light-up night. Please stay tuned for a day for decorating with the kids.

The next meeting will be on November 2. This is the first Monday not the second Monday of the month for this meeting only. The meeting schedule was changed so that the president can be present.
