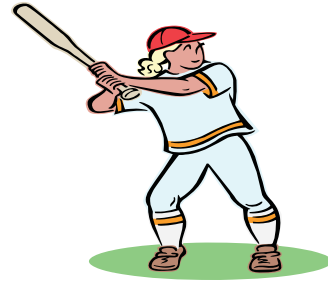


# ETJ Baseball Meeting
