We set dates for Baseball/ Softball registration. Bruce Baker approved the dates for us. The dates will be January 7 (Saturday) and January 12 (Thursday evening) and the final sign-ups will be February 4(Saturday). The draft will follow shortly after sign-ups. Sam Amenti place signs at Martins, Kimmie's and Nagle's house again. Charlie Nagle has the flyers that we need to get put up around the township.

A draft date will be announced soon. We will have the draft at the Upper Deck in Summerhill; we are no longer allowed to use the Jackson gym. Chad has three dates in- February 18- 25 and March 4th- he will hear back from the Upper Deck in the next few days with the exact date. The time frame will be 8-1.

Molly Stine will do our pictures again. Baseball date is confirmed for April 22, starting at 9 am- rain- date is set for April 23. April 29th has been confirmed for Softball, starting at 9 am also. Rain date will be April 30th. Picture Schedules will be made after the draft.

Jon is looking to confirm the baseball clinic again this year with Central Cambria Baseball players. He is trying for the date of April 29th from 10-12. This was a great event last year for our players.

We did not have anyone from softball present. Steve did report through e-mail that he will be in touch with softball coaches about rule changes and suggestions for the CSFPS.

Leidy Lane is in need of a concession manager. Stacy Serenko will do the ordering for both concessions, but will not run the stand. We need someone to step up and take this position. We will not open the Leidy concession without someone from softball willing to help out.

Fundraising for 2017

Lisa Hessler will organize the basket party – she is going to need a team to help with this task. We need parents from both softball and baseball involved. We absolutely need this fundraiser to maintain our normal improvements. The basket party will be held on April 2, 2017 at Saint John Vianney Hall; we will have more space and better parking. Sam Amenti is going to talk with Cooper Signs about making some advertisement signs for this event.

Gun Ticket- we are looking to run same ticket with exception of 7 days/7 guns instead of 10/10. This should help make this fundraiser more profitable, plus we will be using Lecorchick's Sporting Supplies. These two changes will allow the League to profit \$1,490.00 more than the past two years. Guns are scheduled to go off May 14-20, 2017.

A letter will go home with the gun tickets this year. We will have 1 turn in date only! We will have uniform pick-up this year- you will get your uniform when you turn in the tickets. We cannot have tickets and money turned into different people. No Tickets- No Shirt- No Play!

All-Star tourney dates. Machine Pitch July 9-12, and the 10U and 12U tourneys will be July 13-18. Need tourney directors for all of these. This is our biggest fundraiser of the year and gets us through the winter and helps for startup.

We are looking to get batting cages at Leidy, so fundraising is needed!

Finally- Amy has been working with Richland Plastics to get ETJ decals made for softball and baseball. The decals will be \$4 and the magnets will be \$5. We will have forms available at registration. You can pay then or send orders to Amy by Feb. 13th.
